

Signing up to receive SCPD Nixle Messages

The easiest way to sign up to receive Nixle messages from the Suffolk County Police Department is by going to our website: www.suffolkpd.org

Once there, you can simply click on the “Nixle” button at the top of the page (shown in the image to the right).

Signing up to receive SCPD Nixle Messages

To begin the signup process for Nixle simply fill in the fields for:

- Mobile Number
- Email Address
- Zip Code

The mobile number is used to send text message notifications to your cell phone.

The email address allows Nixle to send pertinent email messages to you.

The Zip Code field is used to send geographically targeted alerts based on your address.

Note – You can choose to leave the “Mobile Number” field blank should you wish to only receive information via email.

By clicking the “Settings” tab, you are now brought to the “Directory & Subscriptions” page.

On this page you unsubscribe to Business names by clearing the check box if you wish. Take note that the “Send all messages to my email address” box is always checked by default.

In the column on the right, you can also see that the default setting is to send Alerts, and Advisories to mobile phones.

By clicking on the dropdown box (as shown on the left) you can choose why types of messages you wish to receive via text message.

Signing up to receive SCPD Nixle Messages

By clicking the “Account” tab, you can modify your account settings.

As highlighted in the image to the right, please note that you can modify your account settings to ensure that you don’t receive text messages from Nixle during specific hours of the day (mainly used to stop messaging while you are sleeping).
